# **DEIRDRE MARSHALL, MD, FACS**

Miami plastic surgeon, Dr. Deirdre Marshall, is one of Florida's leading physicians in the realm of plastic and reconstructive surgery. For thirty years, she has practiced both aesthetic and reconstructive plastic surgery in South Florida, in both private practice and in teaching positions at the University of Miami, Miami Children's Hospital and HCA Florida Kendall Hospital.

Dr. Marshall received her undergraduate degree in French literature from Yale University. She attended Stanford University Medical School and thereafter completed Stanford University's Integrated Internship and Residency program in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. She completed fellowships in Hand and Microsurgery at the L'Institut Français de la Main in Paris and in Cosmetic Surgery at the Robbins Institute in Miami Beach.

Dr. Marshall has taken part in numerous overseas plastic surgery missions to provide care to patients in poverty-stricken areas and to train local surgeons in areas ranging from Southeast Asia to Central and South America.

Dr. Marshall has received numerous honors including the Katherine M. McCormick Foundation Award for Women in Medicine and the Stanford University School of Medicine Research Honors Award. Her special areas of interest currently include breast reconstruction and aesthetic surgery.

Dr. Marshall is actively involved in breast cancer support groups, the Miami Society of Plastic Surgeons, the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, and in mentorship programs for undergraduates, medical students, and nurses.

Dr. Marshall's parents, both physicians from Belfast, Northern Ireland, inspired her to pursue a career in medicine. A proud mother of six children aged 29-18, Dr. Marshall is honored that her daughter is following tradition and currently training in Plastic Surgery at USC in Los Angeles.
